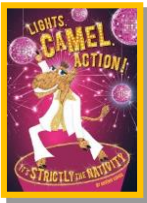
The PTA would like to thank everyone who attended the Christmas Fairs at Monkton Farleigh and Atworth on Saturday.

Come and join the families and friends of BOASW as the children and young people present the nativity 2016.



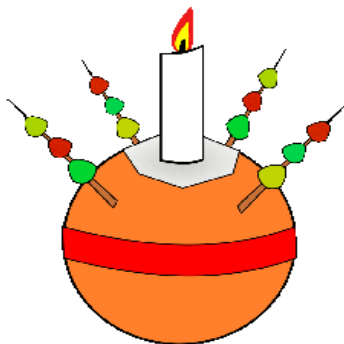
