

The Statutory Assessment Tests 2017 for Year Two Pupils

Two reading papers

Two maths papers- 75% of the overall marks are awarded to number, 25% to Shape, space, measures and data handling (no equipment, ruler only for reasoning paper)

A spelling test with a grammar and punctuation test (optional)

Writing is assessed throughout the year by teachers

Tests are in May no set dates, loose time limits

All children will attempt all tests

Scaled scores (< or > 100) - no pass or fail

Tests will inform teachers' judgements and are simply another piece of evidence to back up those judgements

The judgements reported are:

- Towards Expected standards WTS
- At expected standard EXP
- At greater depth in the expected standard GD

All teachers meet to moderate work to ensure consistency and agreement and have been provided with exemplification materials from DfE

25% of schools will be externally moderated in June
