We are pleased to inform you about the exciting upcoming school trip that will take place on Wednesday 4th October to the Bath Children's Literature Festival.

All EYFS and KS1 children will have the opportunity to meet Ben Faulks, aka Mr Bloom from CBeebies. This promises to be an exciting event where the children will hear about his two books, *What Makes a Me a Me* and *Watch Out For Muddy Puddles*, and take part in his interactive workshop.

KS2 children will have the opportunity to find out more about *The Demon Headmaster*, with the author Gillian Cross. The series is back with a new story and children will be taken behind the scenes of Hazelbrook Academy, with their mysterious new Headmaster. There will be plenty of storytelling tips and KS2 children will be able to join in with her, making up new characters.

KS1 children will be leaving promptly at 9am and travelling to Bath by coach, ready for the event to start at 10am. They will be returning to school by lunchtime, so normal lunchtime arrangements will apply. KS2 children will be leaving school later in the morning, ready for their event to start at 11.30am, and will be returning after lunch. All children in KS2 will therefore need to bring a packed lunch. If your child receives free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided. All children need to wear school uniform, a raincoat and bring a water bottle and snack.

We are incredibly grateful to the PTA for contributing towards the cost of the coach. We kindly ask that the remaining cost is met by parents and request a voluntary £5 contribution towards this. Please be aware that if we do not receive sufficient contribution then the trip will be unable to go ahead.
