

## Ukulele Club

Dear Parents,

As you may be aware I run a ukulele club in school for children in Years 5 and 6. The aim of the club is to have fun whilst learning a musical instrument and to develop a lifelong interest in playing music. It also gives children the valuable experience of playing music and singing as a part of a group.

The ukulele is great fun to play and its small size makes it a perfect instrument for children to learn. It has a bouncy happy sound and a volume suited to accompanying children's voices. The content of the club varies depending on the musical interests of the individuals in the group, but we always cover useful chords and strumming patterns, and go on to explore finger picking, melody playing, song-arranging and song-writing, depending upon the group interests.

The club runs once a week during Tuesday lunchtime and costs £3.50 per child per half hour session. Ukuleles are provided.
