

Topic Home Learning Term 3 & 4 2019

Topic-based homework offers the children a chance to explore their learning in their own way and to undertake more collaborative projects if they would like to. They are designed to allow the children to express their own interests. Ideas are given around a topic, but children are free to interpret them in their own way. Term 3 is based around Australia and term 4 The Great Fire of London.

In response to parent feedback, we have also included some more structured formats as suggestions for those who would prefer greater guidance.

Children should complete at least one piece of homework per short term, and will be given a certificate with feedback upon completion. Presenting their work in class is a fantastic way to develop their speaking and listening skills, and children can celebrate each other's success.
