## **POLICY & PROCEDURE**

- Churchfields, the Village school is committed to offering a range of clubs/activities at both bases.
- Teachers are encouraged to lead one or more clubs.
- The choice of focus will be discussed/negotiated by all staff to enable a balanced choice to be offered.
- Numbers will be limited by the activity/resources available at the discretion of the leader.
- Parental permission/sign up will be sought prior to a child joining any club.
- Any parent or other club organiser running a club/activity will normally be expected to have the support of one member of staff, e.g. for liaison purposes and for duty cover, to support the volunteer in case of an emergency. A parent or other club organiser with appropriate qualifications and/or experience may be permitted to run the club alone at the discretion of the headteacher.
- Any organisers not accompanied by a member of staff for the whole time the club is running will be vetted in line with the school's safeguarding procedures beforehand.
- Any child wishing to join a club must be prepared to attend each week.
- There will be no charge made for attendance if the club is run by a member of staff.
- There may be a charge for resources (where appropriate).
- If sport matches are organised by the school and held at home or away then a member of staff must be present.
- Children may be transported by car if parental permission is sought beforehand.
- A high standard of pupil behaviour will be expected at all times on or off site.
- Year six pupils will typically be expected to attend a SATs preparation 'Homework Club'.
