Dear Parent/Carer.

You may be aware from recent media coverage that the National Education Union (NEU) has declared strike action which will take place on **1 February and 2**, **15 and 16 March**. This is happening because of a national dispute between the union and the government over teachers' pay and conditions, not because of any issues at our school.

Once the school has received official notification from the NEU and I am made aware of which of their members at Churchfields will be undertaking strike action, I will immediately begin planning ahead for the above days. This will involve me carefully considering the extent to which either base can remain open, either fully or partially, on each of the strike days.

Not all teaching staff at Churchfields are NEU members, and not all NEU members may decide to undertake strike action.

When planning possible partial or full school closures, my decision will be based on a number of factors, such as whether the reduced number of staff available will affect the school's ability to safeguard children and ensure their health and safety. For example, as a result of a reduction in the number of first aiders on site or whether there are sufficient staff to provide adequate pupil supervision. Children's safety must and will always be my top priority.

If there is a partial school closure, updated guidance from the Department for Education indicates that schools should prioritise places for vulnerable pupils and the children of critical workers, similarly to when schools were partially closed as a result of the pandemic. The school determines which children come under the vulnerable category using various factors. However, we depend on you to inform us if you are a critical worker and would like your child(ren) to be prioritised for a school place. Critical workers include certain people working in health & social care; education & childcare; key public services; local & national government; food & necessary goods; public safety & national security; transport; and utilities, communication & financial services.

The school may be required to request evidence of critical worker status. Names cannot be added to the critical worker list if this evidence is then not provided.

No school places are guaranteed at this stage until I am aware of the staffing complement available at the school on the intended strike days. However, I will ensure you are kept informed in a timely manner in case you need to make alternative arrangements for your child(ren). Thank you for your support and patience in the meantime.
