School recipe Book



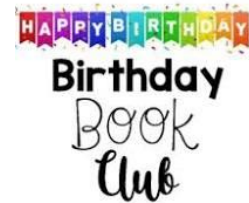
We are delighted to tell you all the recipe books is now complete and ready to order.

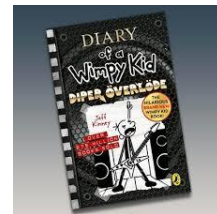
